- Care for God's Creation.

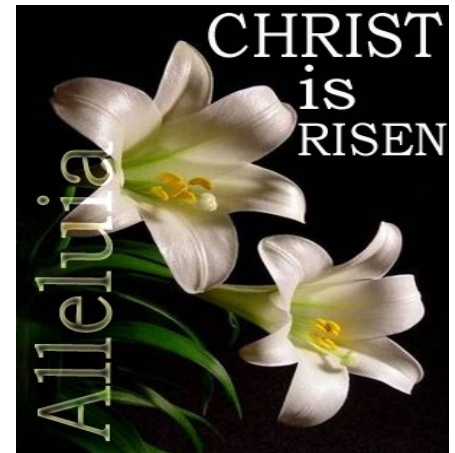
The social teaching of the church is an essential part of our Catholic faith. At the heart of all Catholic Social Teaching is the protection, love, and care for all humans and creation.
